- Note 1: Graduate students are required to pay the base tuition and fees each semester (until graduation), as well as the basic credit fee (for the first four semesters).
- Note 2: The credit fee is 3,340 NTD per credit. The calculation for the basic credit fee is as follows: credit fee per credit × (the required graduation credits for each department/division) ÷ 4.
- Note 3: For international students and Mainland Chinese students at the university, the credit fee for undergraduate courses is 3,340 NTD per credit. If a student enrolls in a 0-credit course during the fall or spring semester, no fee will be charged. However, for 0-credit courses taken during the summer, the fee will be calculated based on the number of class hours, with each hour charged at the rate equivalent to 1 credit.
- Note 4: Graduate-level courses taken during the summer session are subject to credit hour tuition fees by school regulations. For summer courses with 0 credit hours, tuition will be calculated based on the total instructional hours, with each hour charged at the standard rate equivalent to one credit.
- Note 5: Program Credit Requirement Adjustments. The following changes to graduation credit requirements will take effect:

Master's Programs:

- Starting from the 2023 Fall semester:
 - Department of Business Administration, Graduate Institute of Finance, and Technology Management – increased from 36 to 42 credits.
- Starting from the 2024 Fall semester:
 - Department of Applied Foreign Languages and Graduate Institute of Digital Learning and Education – increased from 24 to 30 credits.
- Starting from the 2025 Fall semester:
 - Graduate Institute of Patent – increased from 24 to 36 credits.

Doctoral Programs:

- Starting from the 2023 Fall semester:
 - Graduate Institute of Finance – increased from 24 to 30 credits.
- Starting from the 2024 Fall semester:
 - Graduate Institute of Digital Learning and Education – increased from 18 to 30 credits.

- **Note 1:** Effective from the 2019 academic year, during the extended period of study (the 5th and 6th year), students should pay half of the miscellaneous fees for Registration. For Credit fees:
 - a) students who take 10 credits or more must pay the full amount of tuition and miscellaneous fees.
 - b) student who take 9 credits or less must pay credits fee according the above tuition chart.
 - c) 0-credit courses (eg. PE courses) are calculated based on the number of class hours, and each hour is charged at the standard of 1 credit.
- **Note 2:** Students who take Summer courses are required to pay the credit fees as the above chart. 0 credit courses are calculated based on the number of class hours, and each hour is charged at the standard of 1 credit.
- **Note 3:** International Semiconductor Processing and Equipment Engineering Program established by College of Engineering in 2025 Fall Semester, the fee standard is followed with College of Engineering.
